Devotion Leaders should give Devotion at both Sunday services or arrange a substitute. Mark changes on schedule on refrigerator.

Devotions should be about 3 minutes, one typed page.

Prepare communion trays for both Sunday services; six congregation trays, one server's tray and one juvenile church tray. On 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sundays completely fill the server's tray to serve the Choir. Serve the Choir after the Servers. Use 3 trays for early service. Refill trays from early service to provide 6 trays and server tray for second service.

**Wipe the cup insert holes to minimize stuck cups. Fill cups to line of tray insert cup holder, about ½ full. Full cups are difficult to handle without spillage.**

**Leave alternate cup locations on inner ring empty to make it easier for congregants to take the cups out.**

Add bread to trays the morning of services. This prevents stale taste due to drawing moisture overnight in refrigerator.

Servers are not prescheduled. If you want to serve, take one of the server badges from the badge board. John Spatafora, Ryan Gravemann and Bob Williamson will ask for server volunteers as needed.
